## PARADE INFORMATION

**DATE:** July 9, 2016, 2:00 PM

**LINE-UP:** 12:30 PM Grand Boulevard – All entries must check in at the Parade Check-In Station located at Wentz Avenue and Grand Boulevard. At check-in you will be assigned a parade number and additional parade information.

**PARADE ROUTE:** Parade travels down Main Street, turns left on North Gamble Street and ends at Tucker Avenue.

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE:** June 30, 2016. Late entries will be placed at the end of the parade with no exceptions.

**PARADE JUDGING:** Judging will take place between 1:00 PM and 1:30 PM, floats not in place at this time will not be judged.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

All participants riding bicycles, skateboards, scooters, all-terrain vehicles, etc., are required to wear helmets.

All floats are required to have a working fire extinguisher on board.

All horses are required to be followed by a scooper.

Parade Officials reserve the right to deny entry for any reason.
